Three reasons we can find hope in the resurrection...

I. JESUS IN A RESURRECTION.

- A. Jesus is our _____ on heaven! John 14:19 "Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me.
 - Because I live, you also will live." NIV John 11:25-26 "Jesus said to her, <u>T</u> am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; 26 and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" NIV John 6:40 "For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and
 - believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." NIV
 - Matthew 22:31-32 "But about the resurrection of the dead-have you not read what God said to you, 32'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? He is not the God of the dead but of the living.'" NIV

- B. Paul ______ in the resurrection. 2 Corinthians 4:14 "Because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in his presence." NIV
 - 1 Corinthians 6:14 "By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also." NIV
