How should Christians respond to homosexuality?

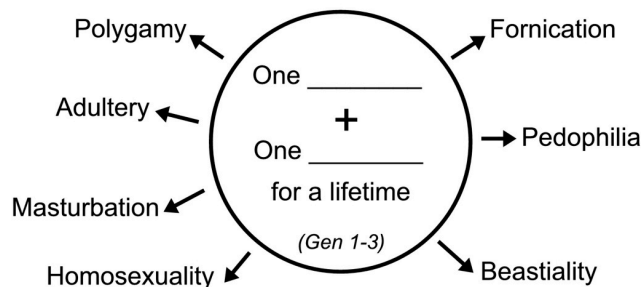
**I. We must always respond \_\_\_\_\_.**  
1 Peter 3:15-16

**II. Argument #1: "Homosexuality is not a sinful \_\_\_\_\_ but pre-ordained by \_\_\_\_\_."**  
Romans 3:23 — "For all have sinned . . ."; Romans 1:18-32

A. The Christian Response:

1. No sexual orientation — chosen or genetic — \_\_\_\_\_ us from living within God's moral boundaries.
