## Five answers from John 1:1-5

**John 1:1** — In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

**Genesis 1:1** — In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

### I. Jesus is God

**Revelation 19:13** — He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God.

**John 1:2** — He was in the beginning with God.

**Romans 9:5 (NLT)** — Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob are their ancestors, and Christ himself was an Israelite as far as his human nature is concerned. And he is God, the one who rules over everything and is worthy of eternal praise! Amen.

### II. Jesus is Eternal

**Romans 1:20** — For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

**John 1:3** — All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.

### III. Jesus is Creator

**Colossians 1:16** — For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

**John 1:4** — In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

### IV. Jesus is Life

**John 14:6** — Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

**John 1:5** — The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

**Psalms 18:28** — For it is you who light my lamp; the Lord my God lightens my darkness.
