I. QUIT ______ & START ______.

A. Understand, your best isn't ______

Galatians 5:4 You who are trying to be justified by law have been alienated from Christ; you have fallen away from <u>grace</u>. Galatians 3:3 <u>Are you so foolish?</u> After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?

B. Jesus is your ______net! Galatians 2:21 _____I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!

II. DEVOTE YOURSELF TO ______.

A. God's word is imparts <u>GRACE</u> Acts 20:32 "Now I commit you to God and to the <u>word of his grace</u>, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified."

2Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the **knowledge** of God and of Jesus our Lord. Romans 12:2-3

III. PERSEVERE IN <u>PRAYER.</u>

IV. PRACTICE HUMILITY.

A. Humility is a _____

1Peter 5:5-6 Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with <u>humility</u> toward one another, because, <u>"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."</u> 6 <u>Humble yourselves</u>, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may li you up in due time.

V. EMBRACE YOUR ______.

- A. More equals more grace!?! Romans 5:20-6:2 The law was added so that the trespass might increase. But where sin increased, grace increased all the more, 21 so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. 6:1 What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase?" 2 By no means! We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer
