Two Essentials for Making Disciples: HIS WORD - HIS WAY

John 8:31 — “If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine.”

I. HIS WORD

John 14:23 — Jesus answered him, “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.

Romans 10:17 — So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

I Timothy 3:16 — All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Job 23:12 — I have not departed from the commandment of his lips; I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my portion of food.

Psalms 119:105 — Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Matthew 4:4 — But he answered, “It is written, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.””

II. HIS WAY

John 13:12-15 — When he had washed their feet and put on his outer garments and resumed his place, he said to them, “Do you understand what I have done to you? 13 You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet. 15 For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you.

Mark 10:45 — For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

Psalms 100:2 — Serve the LORD with gladness! Come into his presence with singing!

I Peter 4:8-11 — Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. 9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. 10 As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God’s varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
