## I. GOSPEL OF CHRIST

**Galatians 1:11,12** — For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. 12 For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:16 — But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed.

**Galatians 1:17-20** — nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia, and returned again to Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and remained with him fifteen days. 19 But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother. 20 (In what I am writing to you, before God, I do not lie!)

## **II. PAUL'S TESTIMONY**

**Galatians 1:13,14** — For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it. 14 And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers.

**Galatians 1:15,16** — But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, 16 was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone

**Jeremiah 1:5** — Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.

**John 1:12** — But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God

**Galatians 1:15,16** — But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, 16 was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone
