I. DAVID UNDERSTOOD GOD’S _____.

- A. David knew God was completely _____.
 - **Psalm 140:7** Sovereign Lord, my strong deliverer, you shield my head in the day of battle
- B. David knew God was infinite in _____.
 - **Psalm 32:1** Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.
 - **Psalm 130:4** But with you there is forgiveness, so that we can, with reverence, serve you.
- C. David knew God was perfect in _____.
 - **Psalm 36:5** Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies.
 - **Psalm 36:7** How priceless is your unfailing love, O God! People take refuge in the shadow of your wings.
 - **Psalm 51:1** Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions.
 - **Psalm 86:13** For great is your love toward me; you have delivered me from the depths, from the realm of the dead.
 - **Psalm 108:4** For great is your love, higher than the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies.
 - **Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
