Three lessons from the trial of Jesus...

I. They held an _____ trial.

- a) Mark 14:53-59 (NIV84) They took Jesus to the high priest, and all the chief priests, elders and teachers of the law came together. 54 <u>Peter</u> followed him at a distance, right into the courtyard of the high priest. There he sat with the guards and warmed himself at the fire.
- b) 55 The chief priests and the whole Sanhedrin <u>were looking for evidence</u> against Jesus so that they could put him to death, <u>but they did not find any.</u> 56 Many testified falsely against him, but their statements did not agree. 57 Then some stood up and gave this <u>false</u> testimony against him: 58 "We heard him say, 'I will destroy this man-made temple and in three days will build another, not made by man.'" 59 Yet even then their testimony did not agree.

What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?" 61 But Jesus remained silent and gave no answer. Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Christ the Son of the Blessed One?"
- b) 62 <u>"I am,"</u> said Jesus." "And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven." 63 The high priest tore his clothes.
