## **HOPE IN SUFFERING**

Four reasons to have <u>HOPE</u> in a hopeless/messed up world:

I. B	<b>Pecause your suffering is 1Peter 1:6</b> In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials.
A.	Our suffering will come to an  1 Peter 5:10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
II. Be	Cause your faith will be  1Peter 1:7 These have come so that your <u>faith</u> -of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though <u>refined by fire</u> -may be <u>proved</u> genuine and may <u>result in praise</u> , <u>glory and honor</u> when Jesus Christ is revealed.
