Four practical keys to biblical giving:

- I. Understand I should give.

 - 1. It is the It is the thing to do. Proverbs 3:9-10 (NIV84) "Honor the LORD with your wealth..."
 - 2. It meets & supplies 2 Corinthians 9:12 (NIV84) "This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of God's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God."
 - 3. It gives to God. 2 Corinthians 9:13 (NIV84) "Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, <u>men will praise God</u> for the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ, and <u>for your generosity</u> in sharing with them and with everyone else."
 - 4. It acknowledges ______ ownership, provision, & protection.

1Timothy 6:17,18 (NIV84) "Command those who are rich in this present world <u>not</u> to be arrogant <u>nor</u> to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, <u>but to put their hope in God</u>, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment."

2. The tithe was introduced

Genesis 14:18 (NIV84) "Then <u>Melchizedek</u> king of Salem brought out bread and wine. He was priest of God Most High, 19 and he blessed Abram, saying, 'Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. 20 And blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.' Then <u>Abram gave him a tenth of</u> everything."

Genesis 28:20 (NIV84) "Then Jacob made a vow, saying ... and of all that you give me <u>I will give you [God] a tenth</u>."

Acts 20:25 (NIV84) [Jesus] "It is more blessed to give than to receive."
