
I. ARE DINOSAURS A MYSTERY?

It depends on our worldview...


- A. What ______ says about dinosaurs:

 - Never lived with man
 - "Ruled earth"... until 65 million yrs ago
 - Killed off by some cataclysm (asteroid?)
- B. What ______ says about dinosaurs:
 - Created on day 6 (Gen 1:24-25) -- 6000 years ago

Genesis 1:24 (NIV84) "And God said, "Let the land produce living creatures according to their kinds: livestock, creatures that move along the ground, and wild animals, each according to its kind." And it was so."

- Lived with man.
- Could not have died out before mn arrived.
- Adam brought sin & death)

A. Job talks about _____. (Oldest record)

Job 40:15-20 (NIV84) "Look at the <u>behemoth</u>, which I made along with you and which feeds on grass like an ox. 16 What strength he has in his loins, what power in the muscles of his belly! 17 <u>His tail sways</u> <u>like a cedar</u>; the sinews of his thighs are close-knit. 18 His bones are tubes of bronze, his limbs like rods of iron. 19 <u>He ranks first among the works of God</u>, yet his Maker can approach him with his sword."

B. The Bible talks about ______. (Leviathan)

Psalm 74:13 (KJV) "Thou breakest the heads of the dragons in the waters"

Job 41:1-34 (NIV84) "Can you pull in the leviathan with a fishhook or tie down his tongue with a rope?"

Psalm 74:13-14 (NIV84) "It was you who split open the sea by your power; you broke the heads of the <u>monster</u> in the waters. 14 It was you who crushed the heads of <u>Leviathan</u>."
