

PRAY CONTINUALLY

1 Thessalonians 5:17



Please keep this prayer reminder in a convenient place so you can pray daily for The Rock Church.

DAY 1 — Pray that our faith would be heightened. “If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you” (Matthew 17:20).

DAY 2 — Pray that we would experience the majesty and power of God. “Great is our Lord and mighty in power; His understanding has no limit” (Psalm 147:5).

DAY 3 — Pray that we would seek Christ’s kingdom first in all our decisions. “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well” (Matthew 6:33).

DAY 4 — Pray that we would know God’s plans for us. “For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future” (Jeremiah 29:11).

DAY 5 — Pray that our church family would be united. “My prayer is not for them alone, I pray also for those who will believe in Me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as You are in Me and I am in You. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent Me” (John 17:20-21).

DAY 6 — Pray that God would use The Rock and its members to accomplish the Great Commission. “Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Matthew 28:19).

DAY 7 — Pray that everyone in our church would serve God wholeheartedly. “But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord” (Joshua 24:15b).

DAY 8 — Pray that we would trust God in all circumstances. “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:6-7).

DAY 9 — Pray that God would help use our gifts for His purposes. “Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms” (1 Peter 4:10).

DAY 10 — Pray that we would not waver from our sincere and pure devotion to Christ. “But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent’s cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ” (2 Corinthians 11:3).

DAY 11 — Pray that we would have self-control. “Like a city whose walls are broken down is a man who lacks self-control” (Proverbs 25:28).

DAY 12 — Pray that we would be bold in sharing the Gospel. “I am not ashamed of the Gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes; first for the Jew, then for the Gentile” (Romans 1:16).

DAY 13 — Pray that God would show us anything that needs changing in our lives. “Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting” (Psalm 139:23-24).

DAY 14 — Pray for the leaders of our church. “I urge you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me” (Romans 15:30).

DAY 15 — Pray that we would understand our adequacy comes from God. “Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, but our competence comes from God” (2 Corinthians 3:5).

DAY 16 — Pray that we would grow closer to God. “You also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ” (1 Peter 2:5).

DAY 17 — Pray that God would give us servants’ hearts. “Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness” (Philippians 2:5-7).

DAY 18 — Pray that God would use us to honor Him no matter the circumstance. “Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in one spirit, contending as one man for the faith of the Gospel” (Philippians 1:27).

DAY 19 — Pray that we will boldly share our faith and help grow God’s kingdom by reaching the lost. “I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ” (Philemon 1:6).

DAY 20 — Pray that we would delight ourselves in the Lord. “Delight yourselves in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart” (Psalm 37:4).

DAY 21 — Pray that we would remain in Christ and live completely dependent upon Him. “I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in Me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing” (John 15:5).

DAY 22 — Pray for more small groups that pray together. “But when our time was up, we left and continued on our way. All the disciples and their wives and children accompanied us out of the city, and there on the beach we knelt to pray” (Acts 21:5).

DAY 23 — Pray that we would love each other. “Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins” (1 Peter 4:8).

DAY 24 — Pray that God would give us words of grace to speak to our friends of differing faiths. “Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the Gospel” (Ephesians 6:19).

DAY 25 — Pray that God would bless us and our church. “Oh, that You would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let Your hand be with me” (1 Chronicles 4:10).

DAY 26 — Pray that we would rest in Jesus, remembering that God is there in hard times. “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you” (Isaiah 43:2).

DAY 27 — Pray that we would take comfort in the Holy Spirit’s intercession for us when we don’t know how to pray. “In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express” (Romans 8:26).

DAY 28 — Pray that we would trust and obey God with our giving. “From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked” (Luke 12:48b).

DAY 29 — Pray for our country and its leaders. “If My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land” (2 Chronicles 7:14).

DAY 30 — Pray that we would trust God for all that we ask of Him. “Trust in Him at all times, O people; pour out your hearts to Him, for God is our refuge” (Psalm 62:8).

DAY 31 — Pray that we would be good stewards of our resources, understanding that all we have belongs to God. “The earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it” (Psalm 24:1).
