Jesus is Better Than Melchizedek

Hebrews 7:11-28
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Two reasons our hope in Jesus is better: I. Jesus is better than (& the Law). A. The Levitical priesthood (and by it the Law) can bring salvation or make us perfect. Hebrews 7:11-12 (NIV84) 11 If perfection have been attained through the Levitical priesthood (for on the basis of it the law was given to the people), why was there still need for another priest to come, one in the order of Melchizedek, not in the order of Aaron? 12 For when there is a change of the priesthood, there must also be a change of the law. 1. The is only useful to show us how <u>bad</u> we are. Galatians 3:24 (KJV) Therefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. Romans 3:20 (NLT) For no one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are. 2. Only people go to heaven. Hebrews 7:18-19 18 The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless 19 (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God. Hebrews 7:15-17 (NIV84) 15 And what we have said is even more clear if another priest like Melchizedek appears, 16 one who has become a priest not on the basis of a regulation as to his ancestry but on the basis of the power of an indestructible life. 17 For it is declared: "You are a priest **forever**, in the order of Melchizedek."
